The tendering firms are requested to submit their sealed offer in two parts: "**Technical Bid**" and "**Financial Bid**" as per the instructions given in tender document. The technical offer and financial offer are to be submitted simultaneously in two **separate** sealed envelopes clearly super scribed '**Technical Bid**' and '**Financial Bid**' in bold letters. Tender no., date and purpose of the tender should also be mentioned clearly on the top of the outer cover. In financial offer, the bid amount should also be written in words. Both the offers should be kept in one sealed envelope super scribed with tender no. and name of item.

- 4. Tender Fee:** Tender forms can be obtained from the Police Sanchar Bhawan Jakhan (S.O.-VIII) Uttarakhand, Dehradun on payment of tender fee Through D.D. of Rs. 265/- only in favour of IG (PHQ) Dehradun on all working days between 1000 hrs to 1700 hrs. Tender form can be downloaded from Uttarakhand Police website will also be allowed. In this condition, D.D.of tender fee should be attached with technical bid.

- 5. Validity** of offer -45 days.
- 6. Financial Offer:** Tendering firms are required to quote base rate, excise, and sales tax etc. separately. Rates should be quoted **F.O.R.** Dehradun. The rate should be written in the prescribed form given with Tender Document. **Itemwise rates will be quoted.**
- 7. Delivery Period:** -30 days

If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct 0.5% per week and the maximum deduction is 10% of the contract from the contract

price, as liquidated damages, of the delivery price of the delayed goods or unperformed services for each week or part thereof of delay until actual delivery or performance. Once the maximum is reached, the purchase may consider termination of the contract.

**8. Earnest Money:** All Tendering firms are required to submit Earnest Money in the form of **Demand Draft/FDR** valid for a period of 180 days beyond the final bid validity period and this period may be extended.

**9.** The tender can also be submitted by post but the department shall not be liable for any postal delays. No Tender will be accepted after the due date and time.

**10.** Tenders, not submitted as per the terms and conditions mentioned in tender document shall be rejected.

**11. Inspection:** Equipment(s)/ Item(s) offered will be demonstrated by suppliers and inspected by Uttarakhand at Dehradun. Only in respect of items found suitable in technical offer the Financial Offers will be opened.

**12 Past performance:** Tendering firms are required to give their past performance certificate

i) Tendering firms are required to give their past performance certificate for the last 5 years.

ii) Under no condition the supply order will be sublet to any other party by the successful bidder.

iii) The bidder must have executed similar type of work costing not less than Rs. 1 Crores per year continuously for the last 5 years.

**13. Payment:** 100% payment after receipt, check and verification of stores as per the condition laid down in tender document.

**14.** The tenders will specify after sales service and support mechanism clearly in the bid. Frequency of routine maintenance during warranty period and breakdown maintenance should also be clearly specified.

**15.** Unless the last date for supply of stores is specifically extended by the purchaser, the supply order is liable to be cancelled after the expiry of stipulated period. In case the tender experiences some genuine problem in supplying the stores within the stipulated period, they are advised to promptly seek extension of delivery period, which may be allowed at the sole discretion of the purchaser.

**16.** Liquidated damages may be imposed for defaults/inordinate delays on the part of the supplier who is also liable to be blacklisted.

**17. Performance Security Money** 10% of the total cost of stores in the form of **Demand Draft/FDR** pledged in favour of IG (PHQ), Dehradun shall be submitted within 21 days from the date of issue of supply order. This should be valid for six months after the date of supply and satisfactory functioning of the equipments including warranty obligation.

**18.** Tenders are required to submit valid Trade Tax Registration No. & PAN Account and their Clearance Certificate along with the technical offer.

**19.** The tenders are required to enclose self-addressed registered stamped envelope along with their technical offer.

**20.** Tenders are advised to go carefully through the tender document and instructions available in the PHQ and ensure compliance before submitting their tender. Conditions other than those mentioned in the tender notice and tender document shall not be acceptable and such offers may be ignored.

**21.** No representation shall be accepted after opening of financial offer.

**22.** If any legal dispute arises regarding tender document the legal jurisdiction shall lie in Dehradun Courts.

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS:-**

**23** All the tendering firms are advised to authorize the person's Name who is signing the tender documents.

**24-** The Firm will have to submit a certificate in the form of challan in lieu of Sales tax deposited with the department before release of balance payment of 25% by the IG Fire and Emergency Services Uttarakhand,

**25.** The purchaser may increase or decrease up to 50% of total quantity to be purchased.

**26.** The Director General of Police Uttarakhand is empowered to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reason.

## **TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION FOR HYDRAULIC SELF CONTAINED COMBINATION TOOL**

The rescue tool shall be designed for spreading, cutting during Rescue Operation.

1. The rescue tool shall be self-contained device with integrated hand pump.
2. It shall be hydraulically operated, lightweight and capable of being operated by one person.
3. The operating system shall have the best ergonomics of functioning. The "Tool Head" or the Handle shall be rotatable at 180 deg in any direction. It should have a Self-Locking or manual locking system.
4. The rescue tool shall be independent from any outside power source and be operated only by a hand lever integrated in the tool itself. The operation shall be extremely user friendly possible by the same person who holds the tool.
5. The head or the handle of the rescue tool should rotate 180 Deg and should be locked in any desired position.
6. Minimum spreading force at the tips in closed position shall not be less than 2.5 tons. Maximum spreading force shall not be less than 12 tons.
7. Spreading distance at the tips shall not be less than 255 mm.
8. Cutting capacity in the recess shall be able to cut 21 mm steel bars.
9. The maximum cutting force shall not be less than 200 KN
10. Weight of ready to use unit with shoulder strap should not be more than 12 kg.
11. The blades shall be of impact free cutting design to overcome the flying of metal pieces during cutting process.
12. The blades shall be able to bite firmly into the work piece and resist any tendency for it to slide forward under the cutting action.
13. The blades of the tool shall be made of drop forged tooling steel and must be one piece without loose parts.
14. The tips of the blade arms must be serrated inside and outside for firm grip during spreading or squeezing.
15. The tool shall be capable of working under extreme conditions, high dusty environment, high humidity & a temperature range from – 15 Deg C to + 70 Deg C. The tool shall be capable of working also in under water conditions up to a depth of approx 40 mtr.
